A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for proposed construction of the Black Field improvement project at Thomas E. Atkins Jr. Memorial Park; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvement; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvement; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on August 1, 2016. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed construction of the Black Field improvement project at Thomas E. Atkins Jr. Memorial Park, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City. Specifically, the proposed improvements include the following:

- Conversion of the infield skin and warning track material from an ag-lime surface to an engineered soil.
- Purchase of an infield tarp, mound tarp and plate tarp for rain events.
- Dugout renovations to enclose the three (3) exterior walls and the installation of electricity within each dugout.
- Purchase of fencing slats for the outfield fence.
- Construction of a storage shed for baseball equipment and field preparation equipment.
- Purchase of backstop padding.
- Expansion of existing bullpens to include two (2) pitching rubbers on each side of the field.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvement project shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements.

SECTION 4. The estimated cost of this proposed improvement project is \$150,000.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for this proposed improvement project shall be reimbursed in full by Columbia College per the terms of Facility Usage Agreement.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvement project specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
