Executive Summary

This is a resolution to set the public hearing for the FY 2017 budget.

Discussion

This resolution will set the public hearing for the 2017 Annual Budget for Monday, August 15. There will be additional public hearings held on Tuesday, September 6, and Monday, September 19 to allow several opportunities for public input on the many items covered by the budget process.

The FY2017 annual budget being proposed by the City Manager has been submitted to the City Council as required by the City Charter. In addition to the public hearings, the City Council will be holding a budget work session to further discuss departmental revenues and expenses proposed for the coming fiscal year. The Council budget work session is Saturday, August 20.

Following the work session and the public hearings, any final adjustments will be made by Council prior to the passage of the budget on September 19.
