Executive Summary

Tourism Development Festival & Events funds (\$7,500) would be granted to the 2016-2017 We Always Swing Jazz Series for marketing & entertainment expenses.

Discussion

The We Always Swing Jazz series (WASJ) presented a Tourism Development Festival & Events application to the Convention & Visitors Bureau for \$10,000 to assist with broadening the marketing efforts of the series and to offset some of the expenses associated with bringing in high caliber headlining entertainment.

WASJ will begin its 22nd season in September 2016. It is one of the country's most well-respected, community-based all jazz projects. There are over 12 performances at various venues, featuring some of the world's finest jazz performers and they have expanded their educational programs and work closely with the Columbia Public School District and the MU School of Music.

WASJ also celebrates "Jazz Appreciation Month" and produces numerous events during the entire month of April. This is a national effort started by the Smithsonian Institution in 2002 with live broadcasts from over 195 countries on the last day of the month. Of the 40 musicians featured in this year's TV broadcast at the nation's capital, 20 have performed in Columbia.

The CVB Advisory Board reviewed the WASJ Tourism Development Festival & Events application at their July 25th board meeting. They voted unanimously to recommend the event be granted \$7,500 in tourism development funds to assist with entertainment costs and to broaden the marketing efforts of the Series to draw in more people from a 90+ mile radius to generate more overnight stays in Columbia hotels during lower occupancy periods.
