Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Youth Leadership in Tobacco Prevention Contract between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services in an amount not to exceed \$4,891.00. The contract period is October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017.

Discussion

The purpose of this funding is to prevent and decrease youth tobacco use and increase youth leadership skills in Boone County. The funding will be used to provide youth tobacco prevention training and activities. Reducing youth smoking was identified as a priority by the Community Health Assessment, and therefore, it is a priority of the Department.
