Executive Summary

The City has amounts (termed miscellaneous accounts receivables) which are owed to the City unrelated to utility accounts that become uncollectible. The attached Resolution authorizes the Finance Director to write-off \$174,148.90 uncollectible miscellaneous accounts receivable for the FY2016 year.

Discussion

The Finance department monitors on a monthly basis all miscellaneous accounts receivable amounts owed to the City. The City sends invoices on miscellaneous receivables. When the invoices are past due, the City sends invoices with a notice in red that warns the person that the debt will be sent to collections. These past due statements with past-due warnings noted in red are sent at 30, 60, and 90 days past due. If the debt remains unpaid after 90 days and is over \$25, the debt is sent to the collection agency. If the collection agency is unable to collect the debt after five years, the debt is eligible for write off status.

The attached Resolution would authorize the Finance Director to write-off \$174,148.90 in miscellaneous accounts receivables related to airport fees, bankruptcy, construction dumping, excessive false fire alarm calls, health permits, landfill fees, parking fees, park facility rental, railroad fees, re-inspection fees, sewer repairs, sewer and solid waste fees, special assessments, street sign damages, street flooding damage, and trash/appliance haul-off fees.
