Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing the City Manager to designate the Utilities Department Assistant Director as the Permit Holder for execution of agreements with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources requires to comply with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Electronic Reporting Rule.

Discussion

In October 2105, the United States Environmental Protection Agency published the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Electronic Reporting (eReporting) Rule [80 FR 64063]. This rule requires any facility with a NPDES permit that requires monitoring and reporting to begin submitting the discharge monitoring reports (DMRs) electronically. The Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) notified the City in October 2016 that MDNR would start requiring the DMRs to be submitted using the Electronic Discharge Monitoring Report (eDMR) system. The Columbia Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant is required to submit application to begin using the eDMR system by December 21, 2016.

This ordinance authorizes the City Manager to designate the Assistant Director of the Utilities Department as the permit holder for execution of application agreements required for compliance with the eDMR requirements. A copy of the correspondence from MDNR and a sample of the application agreement is attached.
