AN ORDINANCE

amending Chapter 14 of the City Code to establish one-way direction for the alley between Eighth Street and College Avenue; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 14 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 14-203. One-way streets and alleys designated.

One-way streets and alleys are designated as follows, and traffic on such streets and alleys shall move only in the direction indicated:

Alley, extending from Sixth Street to Hitt Street, between Cherry Street and Broadway, easterly, during the hours between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Alley, extending from Short Street to Seventh Street, between Walnut Street and Broadway, westerly.

Alley, extending from Woodson Way north to Elm Street, between Watson Place and Hitt Street, northerly.

Alley, extending from Eighth Street to Tenth Street between Broadway and Walnut Street, easterly.

<u>Alley</u>, extending from Eighth Street to Short Street, between Broadway and Walnut Street, easterly.

Alley, extending from a point 180 feet east of Short Street to College Avenue, between Broadway and Walnut Street, easterly.
