Executive Summary

This is the feedback received from the Vehicle Stops and Listening Tour Summary.

Discussion

The Vehicle Stops and Listening Tour Summary Report (attached) was presented to City Council on November 6, 2017. Following this report, City Council requested time for the public to comment due to the voluminous amount of information. The feedback period was from November 17, 2017 until January 12, 2018. The feedback period was advertised on the City website with its own link on the homepage, pushed out through City social media channels and a press release.

This report was posted online, on the City's website, and at the request of City Council, a table of contents with hyperlinks to specific parts of the report was provided to make the report easier to navigate. Paper copies of the report were also posted at the City Clerk's Office and the Columbia Public Library with paper forms to collect feedback.
