#### Executive Summary

Staff is requesting to appropriate \$100,000 from the Custodial and Building Maintenance retained earnings account to their operating account for expenses related to a City-Wide Building Assessment project.

Discussion

On January 16, 2018, Council adopted Resolution 7-18 authorizing an agreement with All Environmental, Inc., d/b/a AEI Consultants to conduct a facility condition assessment, asset inventory bar coding and Level I energy audits for 23 City-owned and occupied facilities. The project cost was initially expended from the Public Works Building Maintenance contractual services account. With this appropriation, staff is reimbursing the Building Maintenance operating account from their retained earnings account.
