Re: Long Term Street Closure of S. Seventh Street between Locust and Elm Streets, and a Sidewalk Closure on the South Side of Elm Street between S. Sixth and S. Seventh Streets

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution authorizing the University of Missouri to close a portion of S. Seventh Street between Locust Street and Elm Street, and a portion of sidewalk on the south side of Elm Street between S. Sixth Street and S. Seventh Street from May 15, 2018 until August 10, 2018. These closures are being requested to allow for rehabilitation of steam chases and manholes, and the installation of utilities serving the Center for MO Studies Building.

Discussion

The University of Missouri has requested street and sidewalk closures for the period May 15, 2018 until August 10, 2018 at the following locations:

- S. Seventh Street between Locust Street and Elm Street
- Sidewalk on the south side of Elm Street between S. Sixth Street and S. Seventh Street

The University's contractor will be making repairs to existing steam chases and manholes serving the Heinkel, Psychology, and Lee Hills buildings, and will also be requesting a future right of use permit agreement to install utilities to serve the Center for Missouri Studies building. Eighteen parking spaces will be affected by this closure and the University and/or its contractor will be responsible for the purchase of parking meter bags to recoup the loss of revenue during the street closure. Staff has reviewed the attached traffic control plans and has no issues with their request. The University of Missouri owns all buildings adjacent to these closures, and is exempt from any public inconvenience fee.

The University of Missouri and/or its contractor will be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The University of Missouri and/or its contractor will be responsible for obtaining parking meter bags to recoup the loss of revenue from 18 affected parking spaces.
