Re: Ordinance Approving Intergovernmental Contract for the State Music Festival

Executive Summary

This ordinance will formally approve and ratify the contract with The Curators of the University Missouri formally authorized by R54-18 for the Missouri State Music Festival 2018-2022.

Discussion

The City of Columbia has entered into a five-year agreement with the Missouri State High School Activities Association (MSHSAA) and The Curators of the University of Missouri to host the State Music Festival. The agreement was not finalized by all three parties until two weeks prior to the start of the 2018 event and required an expedited execution which was done at the April 16, 2018 Council meeting with Resolution 54-18. Because this is a five-year agreement and because the state law requires intergovernmental contracts be approved via ordinance, this legislation formally approves and ratifies said agreement.
