AN ORDINANCE

declaring it is in the public interest to proceed with construction of the Portland Street and Lansing Street water main replacement project; approving the plans and specifications; determining that the work shall be bid by The Curators of the University of Missouri per the terms of a cost-share agreement; providing for payment for the improvement; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

WHEREAS, an interested parties meeting for the proposed construction of the Portland Street and Lansing Street water main replacement project was held by the City Utilities Department – Water and Light Division on June 14, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has adopted a resolution declaring the necessity for the proposed construction of the project; and

WHEREAS, the notice of a public hearing on this project was published in a daily newspaper of general circulation in the city; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing on the project has been held.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Council finds and determines that the upgrade of the water distribution infrastructure along portions of Portland Street and Lansing Street, adjacent to the Women's and Children's Hospital, more specifically to include the replacement of 6-inch cast iron water mains with 8-inch PVC water mains, is necessary for the welfare and improvement of the City and that it is in the public interest that such improvement be made.

SECTION 2. The plans and specifications for this improvement are hereby approved.

SECTION 3. Per the terms of a cost-share agreement with The Curators of the University of Missouri, the University is hereby authorized to call for bids and execute a contract for the improvement.

SECTION 4. Payment for this improvement shall be made from the Water and Electric Fund using funds appropriated in Capital Improvement Project No. W0130, and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated. Per the terms of the cost-share agreement, the City of Columbia will reimburse The Curators of the University of Missouri an amount not to exceed \$220,000.00 and the University is responsible for the balance of the project costs.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
