ADMINISTRATIVE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Project name and brief description: Columbia Cosmopolitan Recreation Area: Bocce Courts — The Parks and Recreation Department is proposing to use park staff to construct four bocce courts at Cosmo Park. The four courts will be constructed on the southwest side of the park adjacent to the tennis complex. The bocce courts will meet United States Bocce Federation standards measuring 13 feet wide and 91 feet long. Park staff will complete all necessary concrete flatwork, ADA walkway construction, bench seating areas and court construction. The courts will be finished with a crushed oyster shell playing surfacing which is the preferred surfacing for regulation tournaments and events. The bocce courts will be open to the public during park hours and will be heavily used by the Department's Special Olympics program. Park staff has met with the Special Olympics staff to review the proposed plans and receive approval for the plans from the program. As budgeted in the City's FY-2017 CIP, the improvements will be funded by the 2015 Park Sales Tax. The bocce court project is anticipated to be completed by spring 2019.
