A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for the proposed installation of traffic calming devices on Sexton Road between Business Loop 70 and Providence Road; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvements; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvements; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, interested parties meetings for the proposed installation of traffic calming devices on Sexton Road between Business Loop 70 and Providence Road was held by the Public Works Department on November 30, 2017 and March 15, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on August 6, 2018. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed installation of traffic calming devices on Sexton Road between Business Loop 70 and Providence Road, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City but desires to hear from the public prior to taking further action to authorize construction of the project. Specific improvements include the installation of six (6) speed humps at the following locations along Sexton Road:

- West of Mikel Street •
- West of Madison Street
- East of Jefferson Street •
- East of Oak Street •
- West of Mary Street •
- East of Woodlawn Avenue •

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvement shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements. Following the public hearing the City Council shall determine whether it is in the public interest to make the proposed public improvements or any part thereof.

SECTION 4. The estimated cost of this proposed improvement is \$30,000.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for this proposed improvement shall be made from Annual Traffic Calming Funds allocated within the Capital Improvement Sales Tax Fund, and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvement specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
