Executive Summary

A public hearing is being held to consider a change to the fare for paratransit service by increasing the fee from \$2.00 to \$3.00 per ride effective June 1, 2019.

Discussion

Staff proposes to increase the paratransit fee to \$3.00 per ride effective June 1, 2019. The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) regulations will not allow ADA transit fares to exceed twice the cost of a regular fare on the fixed route system, which is currently \$1.50, thus raising the fare by \$1.00 to the maximum of \$3.00, would recoup approximately \$57,000 in annual revenue. The proposed fare increase would not enable additional services, but would help defray the rising costs to provide paratransit service

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The increase of the Paratransit fare to \$3.00 would result in an annual revenue increase of approximately \$57,000.

Long-Term Impact: Estimated annual revenue increase of approximately \$57,000.
