A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for the proposed construction of improvements at the Clyde Wilson Memorial Park to include the construction of amenities at three (3) park entrances, repairing portions of the trail surface, replacing existing retaining walls and railroad timbers, and the removal of invasive vegetation encroaching on the trail; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvement; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvement; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, an interested parties meeting for the proposed construction of improvements to the Clyde Wilson Memorial Park to include the construction of amenities at three (3) park entrances, repairing portions of the trail surface, replacing existing retaining walls and railroad timbers, and the removal of invasive vegetation encroaching on the trail was held by the Parks and Recreation Department on July 12, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on September 4, 2018. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed construction of improvements at the Clyde Wilson Memorial Park, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City but desires to hear from the public prior to taking further action to authorize construction of the project. Specific improvements include the following:

- 1. Construction of amenities at the three (3) following park entrances:
 - Wilson Avenue entrance: Construction of a 25-foot by 14-foot a. concrete pad and installation of a new park sign, water fountain, bench, dead end bollards and trash and recycling containers.
 - b. Rollins Road entrance: Construction of a 30-foot by 8-foot concrete pad and installation of a bike rack, park sign, bench and trash and recycling containers.

- c. Rockhill Road entrance: Construction of a 4-foot by 5-foot concrete pad and bike rack, park sign, and trash and recycling containers.
- 2. Repair to portions of the trail's gravel surface.
- 3. Replacement of existing retaining walls and railroad timbers.
- 4. Removal of invasive vegetation encroaching on the trail.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvement project shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements. Following the public hearing the City Council shall determine whether it is in the public interest to make the proposed public improvements or any part thereof.

SECTION 4. The estimated cost of this proposed improvement project is \$50,000.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for this proposed improvement shall be made from park sales tax funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvement specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
