Executive Summary

Staff is requesting Council to authorize the City Manager to execute a Professional Engineering Services Agreement, identified as Amendment #1, with Burns & McDonnell Engineering, Inc. for design and construction services for the relocation of wind measuring equipment located next to runway 2-20.

Discussion

The Professional Engineering Services Agreement with Burns & McDonnell Engineering, Inc. will provide design and construction services related to the relocation of wind measuring equipment adjacent to Runway 2-20.

This design and construction services agreement includes work that was identified by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) that will allow the wind indicator to be relocated and allow a line of sight improvement between the primary and crosswind runways. This agreement is identified as Amendment #1 to the original construction services agreement for Runway 2-20 isolated repairs that was approved by Council on August 20, 2018. This project is being funded 90% with FAA funding and matched locally with 10% Transportation Sales Tax.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The Professional Engineering Services Agreement is for a not to exceed amount of \$82,508.00. The FAA will reimburse the City 90% or \$74,257.20. The City will fund 10% or \$8,250.80 with Transportation Sales Tax.
