### **Executive Summary**

Authorize the City Manager to execute a right of use license permit with Shelter Mutual Insurance Company to install and maintain a private decorative wrought iron fence with gates and stone columns within a portion of the right of way of West Ash Street (see attached Exhibits A and B).

#### Discussion

Shelter Mutual Insurance Company is requesting permission to install and maintain a private decorative wrought iron fence with gates and stone columns on the south side of West Ash Street directly north of Shelter Gardens (See Exhibit B). The fence will replace an existing chain-link fence with gates.

The right of use license permit outlines the responsibilities of Shelter Mutual Insurance Company. The work will be scheduled with the division of Building and Site Development, and will not obstruct or block any City street or sidewalk during construction without first obtaining permission from the City.
