## Executive Summary

The Vision Commission process designed to gather community input for the next strategic plan will be complete by the end of the year. Key themes and priorities will be presented in a Commission report advance of next year's Council and staff retreat.

#### Discussion

City Ordinance Sec. 2-303(c) establishes this mandate for the Vision Commission.

(c) Public engagement. The commission, through various means, will collect public input on the strategic and relevant plan initiatives and departmental goals. The commission, in preparation for its annual report submitted to the city council, will hold at least four public hearings for public comment on the current state of city initiatives and collected public feedback.

As part of its contract to facilitate development of the City's next strategic plan, New Chapter Coaching, LLC has been retained to help the Commission design and conduct its own public engagement process, adapted from the successful Columbia/Boone County community health planning model. Groups of 10 - 15 people will be asked to answer 3 - 4 broad questions about community priorities, with City staff compiling and analyzing input for Vision Commission review.

Conversations with low-income persons, older persons, youth, persons with disabilities and businesses generally are scheduled for December. Commission members are free to participate as facilitators, meeting hosts or in other capacities as their time allows.

## Fiscal Impact
