


2050 Long-Range Transportation Plan Survey Results

Survey Background


- The Columbia Area Transportation Study Organization (CATSO) functions as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) responsible for transportation planning in the City of Columbia and central Boone County. CATSO is required to update and adopt a Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) that encompasses a 30 year horizon and focuses on Streets, Bicycle Facilities, Pedestrian Facilities, Regional Transportation, Public Transit, System Maintenance and Interstate Freight every 5 years. The LRTP survey was created and distributed to help CATSO collect community feedback for the development of community oriented priorities for inclusion in CATSO's 2050 LRTP.
- Survey provided in an online format: sent to CATSO transportation stakeholder lists and promoted through a daily, boosted Facebook message on the City of Columbia, Government Facebook page.
- CATSO Area Population: 149,635
- 860 total survey respondents.


How far is your commute directly from home to work (if applicable)? 860 responses.




72% of the CATSO area population commute less than 10 miles to work.

Overall, how would you rate the transportation system in the CATSO area? 819 responses.




How would you rate the quality of the following in the CATSO area? (Very good – Poor)




Quality of Bike/Ped Network

Would you bicycle and/or walk more if additional bicycle and pedestrian facilities were available? (854 Respondents)








Do you think there is a traffic congestion problem in the CATSO area?
