Project name and brief description: <u>Stephens Lake Park: Spraygrounds Ultraviolet (UV)</u> System Replacement – The Parks and Recreation Department is proposing to use force account labor to replace the UV system at the spraygrounds at Stephens Lake Park. The existing UV system was installed approximately 9 years ago and is in need of replacement due to age, current operating issues and improvements in system technology. UV systems in spraygrounds function as a secondary sanitation method to assist in the elimination of chlorine resistant pathogens in the water. Park staff will competitively bid the UV system and complete the installation of the equipment at the spraygrounds. As budgeted in the City's FY-2019 CIP, the replacement of the UV system will be funded by the 2015 Park Sales Tax. The installation of the new UV system will be completed before the spring opening of the spraygrounds on <u>May 1, 2019.</u>
