Re: Authorize a Professional Engineering Services Agreement with Burns & McDonnell

Engineering, Inc. for design services related to the extension of Runway 2-20.

Executive Summary

Staff is requesting Council to authorize the City Manager to execute a Professional Engineering Services Agreement with Burns & McDonnell Engineering, Inc. for design services related to the extension of Runway 2-20; and appropriate funds.

Discussion

The Professional Engineering Services Agreement with Burns & McDonnell Engineering, Inc. will provide design services related to the extension of Runway 2-20. This design will reflect an additional 900 feet to the north end of the primary runway allowing for larger aircraft and enhancing the safety of aircraft currently utilizing the runway. The project cost for design services is \$632,293.00 and is eligible for 90% reimbursement by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) will provide 5% reimbursement and the remaining 5% will be funded with Transportation Sales Tax.

An appropriation in the amount of \$569,063.70 is being requested in this ordinance from the Federal contributions account.

An interested parties meeting was held on November 20, 2018, for this project with no objections from the participants.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The Professional Engineering Services Agreement is \$632,293.00. The FAA will reimburse the City 90% or \$569,063.70. The City will fund 5% from Transportation Sales Tax or \$31,614.65 and 5% from MoDOT or \$31,614.65 which was previously budgeted for FY2019. Long-Term Impact: None
