Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Public Health Emergency Preparedness Contract Amendment #02

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign Amendment #02 to Contract #AOC18380073 for Public Health Emergency Preparedness between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. The contract amount shall not exceed \$161,031 for the period of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019; appropriating funds.

Discussion

This is an amendment to the current Public Health Emergency Preparedness contract between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. This amendment provides an additional \$2,498 for the purchase of supplies and travel and training funding. An appropriation is needed.
