Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing the City Manager to execute a Master Power Purchase and Sale Agreement with NextEra Energy Marketing, LLC.

Discussion

The City of Columbia has been approached by NextEra Energy Marketing (NextEra), LLC for a capacity swap beginning in planning year 2023/2024 (June 2023 – May 2024). Both the City of Columbia and NextEra are utility providers within Midcontinent Independent System Operator (MISO) and are subject to MISO's resource adequacy requirements. Each has Zonal Resource Credits located in MISO zones (Zone 5- NextEra, Zone 4 – Columbia) that are different from their load obligations and would benefit from entering into a local resource zoning capacity swap. The impact of this agreement is to reduce risks associated with balancing credits at the end of the MISO planning year. The swap is proposed to be a zero cost, MW per MW swap in accordance with the following table:

At its May 29th 2019 Water & Light Advisory Board meeting, the Board supported the Capacity Exchange Agreement as it reduces the risks associated with external Zonal Resource Credits used to satisfy Columbia's local capacity requirements.
