Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign a Program Services Contract between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for the Summer Food Service Program.

Discussion

This agreement allows Public Health & Human Services (PHHS) to continue offering the Summer Food Program "Lunch in the Park" in 2019. This program provides nutritious meals to children throughout the summer at Douglass Park. Funding for the program is based on a set price reimbursement for the number of meals served. The is an annually renewing contract and was anticipated in the FY2019 budget process.
