Executive Summary

Approval from Council will allow the City Manager to authorize a Mutual Aid Agreement between the University of Missouri and the City of Columbia. This agreement allows for intergovernmental law enforcement service and assistance between agencies.

Discussion

Approval of this Mutual Aid Agreement between the University of Missouri and the City of Columbia will allow University of Missouri Police and Columbia Police to assist each other with personnel and resources during emergencies and other events that require additional resources.

This agreement helps to define when the resources of each department can be called upon, who has the authority to grant requests for assistance, and other operational guidelines for intergovernmental operations.

By authorizing this agreement, the City and University increase efficiency and effectiveness in safeguarding the public.
