Re: Authorizing construction of the FY 2019 Stormwater Rehabilitation Project, calling for bids through the Purchasing Division and appropriating funds.

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing construction and the call for bids through the Purchasing Division for the FY2019 Stormwater Rehabilitation Project. The public hearing for this project was held on July 1, 2019. Funding for this project will be appropriated from Annual Projects SS017 to FY19 Stormwater Rehabilitation Project SS146. The estimated cost of the project is \$235,400 and will be paid from Storm Water Utility funds.

Discussion

The proposed improvements will consist of rehabilitating approximately 830 linear feet of storm drain pipe at six locations throughout Columbia. See attached location diagrams. Storm pipe lining is proposed for the following locations:

- Ann Street
- Bluff Dale Drive
- McKee Street
- Ridgemont
- Rollins Road at Brewer
- Sinclair Road south of Mill Creek

Staff would anticipate utilizing the term and supply bidding process for this project. A term and supply contract is an appropriate way to construct a maintenance project of this type as it will allow City staff to move swiftly without delays from bidding. This ordinance authorizes constructing these improvements through the City's term and supply contracts or bidding through Purchasing as necessary.

A public hearing was held for this project on July 1, 2019. An Interested Parties (IP) meeting was held on May 7, 2019 for this project and the FY2019 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project. Six people attended the meeting (not including staff, Councilperson Peters, and news reporters).

The estimated cost of the project is \$235,400 and will be paid from Storm Water Utility funds appropriated from the Storm Water Utility Annual Projects account.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: Construction costs are estimated to be \$235,400 and will be paid from Storm Water Utility funds.
