PURPOSE	Acts in an advisory capacity to the council on matters of environmental protection, and assists in planning environmental improvements	Work with city staff and consultants on developing goals and objectives for the Climate Action and Adaptation Plan, assist in the development of a public engagement plan, review project deliverables, and provide recommendations for prioritization of strategies and consideration of technical and community input.	Advisory body to City Council & Staff on the progress of the Climate Action & Adaptation Plan as the City works to achieve greenhouse gas reduction and adaptation goals.
MEMBERSHIP	The EEC shall be composed of ten (10) members. Four (4) members shall be appointed by the Boone County Commission. Six (6) members shall be appointed by the city council. The six (6) members appointed by the city council shall be qualified voters of the city.	The Task Force shall consist of at least fifteen (15) members representative of the Columbia community, including students, and appointed by the Mayor. Members shall be selected from City boards and commissions, the environmental community, local conservation agencies, the social services community, the building and development community, the business community, the insurance industry, major institutions, and subject matter experts.	This group provides diverse perspectives, social networks and expertise critical for successful implementation of the CAAP framework.
REPORTS	Prepares a report to the City Council on how a plan for energy conservation might be developed,.	The final Climate Action & Adaptation Plan	Present annual progress report and budget priorities to City Council for acceptance
