Council Bill No. B289-19 incorrectly identified 1106 E. Walnut Street as the address of the new hotel tower to be constructed that will connect to the existing hotel located at 1111 Broadway. The correct address for the new hotel tower is 1104 E. Walnut Street. An amendment sheet has been prepared to correct the erroneous address location identified within the ordinance.
