Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution granting a temporary waiver from the requirements of section 16-185 of the City Code to allow possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages for the portion of Smith Street between College Avenue and Fay Street for the 2019 Harvest Hootenanny event.

Discussion

Billy Polanksy, Columbia Center for Urban Agriculture, has requested a waiver from the requirements of section 16-185 of the City Code for the portion of Smith Street between College Avenue and Fay Street. The waiver is requested for October 5, 2019, beginning at 3:00 p.m. and ending at 8:00 p.m. The estimated attendance for the event is 1,200 people.

The City Event Committee has approved the Special Events Application pending Council approval. For the last several years, the City Event Committee has approved the closure of Smith Street for this event. The setup for this year's event is similar to years past. Conditions of approval have included use of barricades that are compliant with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) to block the street and procurement of required liquor licensing and liquor liability insurance.
