AN ORDINANCE

amending Chapter 17 of the City Code as it relates to Parks and Recreation fees; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 17 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Additional related persons, residing at the same address, may be added to the pass if they are under the age of 18, are a full-time student (12 credit hours or more) under the age of 25, or qualify as a dependent. Each additional person over five will be an additional \$10.00 per season. Children under the age of two will be admitted for free and will not be counted toward the number of persons in the family.
