Executive Summary

An ordinance has been prepared to authorize the City Manager to sign the Participation Agreement between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for the Tuberculosis (TB) Diagnostic Services Program for the period of July 1, 2019-June 30, 2022.

Discussion

The Diagnostic Services Program provides reimbursement for the provision of tuberculosis diagnosis and control services to low income, uninsured individuals.
