## A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for the proposed construction of a right turn lane and sidewalk on the southeast corner of the intersection of Providence Road and Broadway, as part of the Flat Branch Park Expansion Master Plan; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvement; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvement; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, an interested parties meeting for the proposed construction of a right turn lane and sidewalk on the southeast corner of the intersection of Providence Road and Broadway, as part of the Flat Branch Park Expansion Master Plan, was held by the Convention and Visitors Bureau and the Parks and Recreation Department on January 31, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on October 21, 2019. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed construction of a right turn lane and sidewalk on the southeast corner of the intersection of Providence Road and Broadway, as part of the Flat Branch Park Expansion Master Plan, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City but desires to hear from the public prior to taking further action to authorize construction of the project. Specific improvements are as follows:

- 1. Construction of approximately 360 linear feet of an 11-foot wide turn lane with 10-inch thick concrete pavement.
- 2. Construction of a 10-foot wide concrete sidewalk and integral curb on the east side of the turn lane.
- Relocation of street lighting and the adjustment of existing utilities. 3.
- 4. Street striping and the installation of signage.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvement shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements. Following the public hearing the City Council shall determine whether it is in the public interest to make the proposed public improvements or any part thereof.

SECTION 4. The estimated cost of this proposed improvement is \$130,000.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for this proposed improvement project shall be made from capital improvements sales tax funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvement specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
