Executive Summary

In August 2019, the Chair of the City of Columbia Commission on Human Rights reached out to the Youth Advisory Council (YAC) asking them to consider drafting a letter to the City Council regarding the then-proposed ordinance that would ban the practice of conversion therapy on juveniles.

Discussion

In August 2019, the Chair of the City of Columbia Commission on Human Rights reached out to the Youth Advisory Council (YAC) asking them to consider drafting a letter to the City Council regarding the then-proposed ordinance that would ban the practice of conversion therapy on juveniles. The YAC discussed this at their September 10th meeting and voted to draft a letter to the City Council in support of the ban.

Due to the timing of their meetings, YAC would not be able to produce a letter before the City Council would take action on this item - YAC is made up of local high school students and only meets once a month from September through May. YAC felt, however, that this was an important item impacting youth in Columbia and wanted to provide a letter supporting City Council's unanimous vote to ban the practice of conversion therapy on juveniles and thanking them for their action.
