#### **Executive Summary**

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution granting a waiver from the requirements of section 16-185 of the City Code to allow possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages for the 2019 Joe Machens Family Picnic event at Rose Music Hall.

#### Discussion

Mike Nolan, Manager of Rose Music Hall, has requested a waiver from the requirements of section 16-185 of the City Code. The waiver is requested for a portion of Park Avenue between Tenth and St. James Streets and a portion of Orr Street between Park Avenue and Ash Street. The area will be barricaded off no earlier than 8:00 a.m. until no later than from 8:00 p.m. on October 27, 2019. Nolan has requested the alcohol waiver from 12:00 p.m. (noon) until 8:00 p.m. on that date. The estimated attendance for the event is 1,000 people.

The City Special Event Committee has approved the application for this event pending Council approval. Conditions of approval have included use of barricades that are compliant with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) to block the street and procurement of required liquor licensing and liquor liability insurance.
