Executive Summary

Staff is requesting Council authorize the City Manager to execute a Motor Vehicle Crash Data License agreement with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (MHTC), which will allow access to MoDOT's crash data for the purpose of safety studies.

Discussion

The Motor Vehicle Crash Data License agreement will allow staff access to MoDOT's crash statistics map and reports for the purpose of safety studies which includes identifying the need for planning of safety enhancement improvement projects. This information is vital for various aspects of the Vision Zero program. The agreement is required by MoDOT to ensure the crash reports stay confidential due to the sensitive and personal information that will be identified. Unless otherwise terminated, this agreement shall be in effect for three years from the date of execution.
