Based on the success of the 2019 event, the Committee suggested offering an option for future poster artists to exhibit works for sale at the Celebration of the Arts event with proceeds split between the artist and the fund.

The Committee talked about CoMoGives strategies and how to continue to tell the story of the fund ahead of the end of year campaign.

The committee discussed the potential capital campaign. Questions were raised about

the best timeline to avoid conflicting with ongoing campaigns in the community. The Committee discussed the need for large donors, how to identify donors, campaign levels, and messaging about what the fund does and the future created by gifts to the fund.

Toigo suggested organizing a group of former Commissioners who could continue supporting the fund and fundraising efforts.

Dresser reported that staff would provide a planning timeline and more messaging materials at the next meeting.
