AN ORDINANCE		
amending Chapter 5 of the City Code to establish a provision to exempt certain public and private schools and educational institutions from keeping chickens; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.		
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:		
SECTION 1. Chapter 5 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 5-91. Number and type of chickens allowed.		
(a) The maximum number of chickens allowed is six (6) per tract of land regardless of how many dwelling units are on the tract.		
(b) Only female chickens are allowed. There is no restriction on chicken species.		
(c) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any chickens kept as part of an educational course by public and private schools and educational institutions with fifty (50) or more students when the chickens are kept on school property that is one-half (1/2) acre or more in size.		
SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
