Re: Authorizing a Bid Call for Fabrication of a New Design Bus Shelter.

Executive Summary

Authorize a bid call through the Purchasing Division for the fabrication of a New Design bus shelter. The New Design bus shelter was developed by the Sustainable Technologies class within the University of Missouri Architectural Studies program, once fabricated it will be installed by City transit staff at the bus stop located on Broadway, in front of the Columbia Public Library. The New Design bus shelter was included in an Interested Parties (IP) meeting held on August 13, 2015 and at a public hearing held on October 19, 2015.

Discussion

During the spring semester of 2014, student groups in the University of Missouri Architectural Studies, Sustainable Technologies class, developed and proposed new designs for bus shelters for the Go Como public transit system. The resulting seven designs were presented to the public to vote and a presentation, including the winning project, was presented during the pre-council meeting held on July 21, 2014.

The New Design bus shelter will be installed on the bus pad in front of the Columbia Public Library and will include art work on the front panel of the shelter. A Call to Artists through the Office of Cultural Affairs will be used to obtain design proposals. The New Design bus shelter will also include options for solar lighting/charging station and a green roof.

The estimated total project cost is \$25,000 and the estimate includes finalizing the design, fabrication of the structure and purchasing items such as art work, solar panels, media and vegetation for green roof, etc. The project will be funded through the 1/4 -Cent Capital Improvement Program (CIP) sales tax. Installation is planned for the spring of 2020.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The estimated total project cost is \$25,000 funded with the $\frac{1}{4}$ -Cent Capital Improvement Program (CIP) sales tax.

Long-Term Impact: Routine maintenance of the shelter estimated at no more than \$100.00 annually.
