- Removal of Parking Meters from 8th & Cherry and Short Street Garage;
- Passage of a \$15 Lost Ticket Fee Ordinance;
- Passage of the Parking Garage Hourly Rate Structure Change;

PROPOSED HOURLY RATE STRUCTURE CHANGE

At the August 7th meeting, the Parking Advisory Commission voted to support this rate structure change:

- One dollar (\$1.00)
 for each two-hour
 session unless the
 vehicle remains less
 than (1) hour for
 which there will be
 no charge.
- \circ 0-1 hours = Free
- 1-2 hours = \$1
- \circ 2-4 hours = \$2
- 4-6 hours=\$3
- 6-8 hours=\$4
- 8-10 hours=\$5

CHANGES TO ACCEPTED PAYMENTS & SIGNAGE



HOURLY REVENUES VERSUS MAXIMUM REVENUE, PER GARAGE

Garage	% of current monthly hourly revenue, versus maximum revenue capacity
10 th & Cherry	60%
8 th & Cherry	73%
6 th & Cherry	54%
Short Street	37%
8 th & Walnut	39%
5 th & Walnut	13%

ANTICIPATED SCHEDULE FOR GATE ARMS IMPLEMENTATION

- Mid November: HUB will order PCI-compliant, chipenabled, EMV credit card readers and contactless antennas to allow for near-field communication (NFC) payment options, Samsung Pay, Apple Pay and Google Pay in the municipal parking garages.
- **Beginning of December:** Above stated equipment needed for project initiation expected to arrive. HUB Technologies to start the gate arms system installation process.
- End of January: Initial gate arms installation completed and staff training for gate arms system complete.
- **Beginning of February:** Gate arms Go Live in Plaza (8th & Walnut) and 10th & Cherry garages.
- Mid-February: Gate arms Go Live in 8th & Cherry and 6th & Cherry garages.
- End of February: Gate arms Go Live in 5th & Walnut Garage.
- Early March: Gate arms Go Live in Short Street Garage.
