2-20 at the Columbia Regional Airport

Executive Summary

Staff is requesting Council authorize the City Manager to execute an amendment to the professional engineering services agreement with Burns & McDonnell Engineering Company for construction phase services related to the reconstruction and extension of Runway 13-31 at the Columbia Regional Airport. The amendment is related to the emergency "crown" repair at the intersection of Runway 13-31 and Runway 2-20, at a cost of \$47,836.00. This amount is eligible for 90% reimbursement by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).

Discussion

On October 17, 2016 Council adopted resolution 155-16 authorizing a professional engineering services agreement with Burns & McDonnell Engineering Company for construction phase services related to the reconstruction and extension or Runway 13-31 and partial Taxiway B at the Columbia Regional Airport.

In April of 2019, after pilots and passengers complained about a bump felt during takeoffs and landings, Burns & McDonnell was retained by the City to provide design and construction services for the remediation of the existing surface gradients at the intersection of Runway 2-20 and Runway 13-31. Subsequently, United and American airlines temporarily suspended their flights to allow for the emergency repairs. The cost for the additional services provided by Burns & McDonnell is \$47,836.00. The FAA will reimburse the City 90% or \$43,052.40 of this cost. The City's 10% match will be paid from Transportation Sales Tax.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The amendment with Burns & McDonnell Engineering Company to provide design and construction services related to the emergency repairs is for a not to exceed amount \$47,836.00. The FAA will reimburse the City 90%, or \$43,052.40. The City's 10% match of \$4,783.60 will be paid from Transportation Sales Tax. Long-Term Impact: None.
