Executive Summary

Authorize the City Manager to execute a right of use permit with Boone County, Missouri, Office of Emergency Management to construct and maintain a warning siren with supporting infrastructure within a portion of the right-of-way of Vandiver Drive.

Discussion

Boone County, Missouri, Office of Emergency Management is requesting approval of a right of use permit to construct and maintain a warning siren with supporting infrastructure within the right-of-way of Vandiver Drive. The warning siren will be constructed at a location on the south side of Vandiver Drive, between Sylvan Lane and Nelwood Drive (see attached diagram).

Boone County, Missouri, Office of Emergency Management will not obstruct or block any City street or sidewalk during construction without first obtaining permission from the City. The right of use permit outlines the responsibilities of Boone County, Missouri, Office of Emergency Management.
