A RESOLUTION

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setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for the proposed construction of the Stanford Drive PCCE #21 Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvement; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvement; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, an interested parties meeting for the proposed construction of the Stanford Drive PCCE #21 Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project was held by the City Utilities Department – Sewer/Stormwater Division on December 4, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on February 17, 2020. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed construction of approximately 140 linear feet of gravity sewer main and a sanitary sewer structure, and installation of new private service connections and replacement of necessary service laterals for reconnection to the new sewer main, as part of the Stanford Drive PCCE #21 Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvement shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements. Following the public hearing, the City Council shall determine whether it is in the public interest to make the proposed public improvements or any part thereof.

SECTION 4. The estimated cost of this proposed improvement is \$150,000.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for this proposed improvement shall be made from Sanitary Sewer Utility Funds – Private Common Collector Elimination Funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated or lawfully used for such purpose.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvement specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
