Re: Short-Term Rentals

Cities throughout the U.S. have been concerned about the negative impacts short-term rentals have on their communities and have taken steps to mitigate these impacts. As the City Council debates this issue and proceeds to develop policies to deal with short-term rentals, the Human Services Commission (HSC) recommends:

- Including provisions for revenue generation in the form of fees, surcharges, and/or taxes in these policies. Specifically, the HSC recommends that revenues raised in this way be earmarked for affordable housing initiatives and homelessness initiatives.
- Limiting or banning unhosted short-term rentals.

The HSC believes these policies will alleviate and offset the impacts of short-terms rentals on the housing market in Columbia.
