Re: Department of Public Safety Grant – 2020-2021 STOP VAWA (Domestic Violence Unit Grant)

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing acceptance of the 2020-2021 STOP VAWA grant in the amount of \$162,841.96 from the Missouri Department of Public Safety and authorizing the City Manager to sign the contract.

Discussion

This grant renewal will continue funding a portion of the two DOVE (Domestic Violence) Unit officer's salaries/benefits and provides 51% funding for a temporary part-time employee.

The contract period is January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2021.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The 2020-2021 STOP VAWA Grant will offset the cost budgeted for two existing officer positions and a part time temporary civilian position in FY20 and FY21 (\$162,841.96).

Long-Term Impact: No anticipated cost beyond year two.
