AN ORDINANCE

accepting the 2020-2021 STOP Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) grant from the Missouri Department of Public Safety; authorizing an Award of Contract and Certified Assurances and Special Conditions; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City of Columbia accepts the 2020-2021 STOP Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) grant from the Missouri Department of Public Safety in the amount of \$162,841.96 for the period of January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2021. Any actions taken by or on behalf of the City in connection with such agreement prior to the date of this ordinance are hereby approved and ratified.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, and the City Manager's designee, are authorized to execute the Award of Contract and Certified Assurances and Special Conditions documents with the Missouri Department of Public Safety on behalf of the City agreeing to the terms and conditions of the grant. The form and content of the documents shall be substantially as set forth in "Exhibit A" attached hereto. Any actions taken by or on behalf of the City in connection with such grant prior to the date of this ordinance are hereby approved and ratified.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
