Executive Summary

An ordinance has been prepared to appropriate funds for litigation expenses.

Discussion

An appropriation of funds is necessary in order to support the costs associated with retaining outside legal counsel to represent the City of Columbia in litigation. At the time the FY 2020 budget was prepared, there was a reduction in the Law Department miscellaneous contractual account and it was anticipated that the account would not contain adequate funds for the fiscal year. At this time, staff is requesting that additional funds in the amount of \$95,000 be appropriated from the General Fund unencumbered fund balance to the Law Department-Counselor Division miscellaneous contractual account.
