AMENDMENT NO. 1 to the PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AND ENGINEERING SURVEYS AND SERVICES

This Amendment No. 1 to the November 9, 2016 professional engineering services agreement between the **CITY OF COLUMBIA** ("CITY"), and **ENGINEERING SURVEYS AND SERVICES** ("ENGINEER") is made as of the date of the last signatory noted below.

RECITALS

- A. WHEREAS, on November 9, 2016, CITY and ENGINEER entered into an agreement for professional engineering services for the NIFONG BOULEVARD IMPROVEMENTS – PROVIDENCE ROAD TO FORUM BOULEVARD (hereinafter "Agreement"); and
- B. WHEREAS, the Parties hereto desire to formally amend the Agreement with this First Amendment (hereinafter "First Amendment") to add additional services and desire to be bound by the terms contained in the Agreement as amended by this First Amendment to the Agreement.

AMENDMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual benefit to be derived by the parties, it is agreed to amend the Agreement, as follows.

- Section 6.1.1.1 of the Agreement shall be replaced with the following:
 "For time spent by personnel, payment at the hourly rates indicated in the "Schedule of Hourly Labor Billing Rates" (attached to this First Amendment). Such rates include overhead and profit. The schedule is effective to January 1, 2018, and may be revised thereafter."
- Section 6.1.2 of the Agreement shall be replaced with the following: "Total payment for Scope of Services and all other expenses and costs to City under this Agreement and the First Amendment and described herein shall not exceed nine-hundred sixty thousand and thirty-five dollars (\$960,035)."
- 3. All other terms of the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
