Re: Authorize a Professional Engineering Services Agreement with Burns & McDonnell, Inc. for Construction Phase Services related to the construction of Hangar 730 at the Columbia Regional Airport; and, appropriate funds.

Executive Summary

Authorize the City Manager to execute a Professional Engineering Services Agreement with Burns & McDonnell, Inc., and appropriate funds for the construction of Hangar 730 at the Columbia Regional Airport.

Discussion

Staff is requesting approval of a Professional Engineering Services Agreement to allow for Construction Phase Services during the construction of Hangar 730. These services will assist staff to ensure compliance with federal, state, and local requirements. As part of the terminal building program at the Columbia Regional Airport, the existing Columbia Jet Center (CJC) Hangar 350 building will need to be demolished to allow for the future construction of the new terminal facility. However, before the demolition project occurs, a new hangar (Hangar 730) will be constructed and used to replace the existing CJC Hangar 350 structure. Hangar 730 will be located directly south of Taxilane C2 and northwest of Hangar 40.

The total cost of construction phase services and construction of Hangar 730 is \$2,455,486.50 and there is currently \$2,121,955.45 in AP130. Therefore, \$333,531.05 needs to be appropriated from Transportation Sales Tax of which \$258,214.00 is for construction phase services and an additional \$75,317.05 is for actual construction costs of Hangar 730.
