Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing the acquisition of easements necessary for the construction of the Glenwood Ave PCCE #25 Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project, as shown on the attached Diagram. A public hearing was held on February 17, 2020.

Discussion

The Glenwood Ave PCCE #25 Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project will consist of installing approximately 440 feet of CIPP (Cured in Place Pipe) and constructing approximately 347 feet of new gravity sewer main and five new sanitary sewer structures, as shown on the attached Diagram.

The project will involve the construction of a new gravity sanitary sewer main to eliminate a private common collector (PCC) sewer for two (2) parcels. It will also include the extension and rehabilitation of an existing privately owned sanitary sewer main located in the right-ofway of Glenwood Ave that serves six (6) parcels. Current policy requires that the temporary construction easements and permanent sewer easements necessary for the construction of the project be donated by the property owners of the parcels currently being served by the PCC sewers. However, in addition to the donated easements, this project will require the acquisition of four (4) temporary construction easements (TCE) from three (3) property owners and two (2) permanent sanitary sewer easements (PSSE) from two (2) property owners not benefiting from the project. See attached project graphic of the proposed easements to be acquired.

Construction plans are 75% complete with construction expected in FY2021.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The resolution estimate for the project is \$300,000 and will be paid from the Sewer Utility Private Common Collector Elimination funds.

Long-Term Impact: It is anticipated that this project will have a minimal impact on the Sewer Utility's annual operating cost.
